# FOREWORD

Gore Vidal, picking at the scabs of Socrates, once commented to a predatory video crew that the untelevised life wasn't worth living. Losing the Socratic reference to fatigue, the MTV editors who hacked over 2,000 hours of footage down to the four-and-change that would become 1992's premiere season of *The Real World*, may have suggested that a producer's life wasn't worth much more.

When I was three, I looked at a TV, fell in love with the images on its screen and forgot it wasn't a window. I'd seen plenty of television before that, precociously jaded by the cables juicing the magic with power and an image more resolved than grey waves of static snow, but I'd always seen the television as I'd watched the television. The object always in frame. When an episode of *Wild Kingdom* eventually found me, the electronics fell away and something close to reality attacked a gazelle behind the glass.

Reality wouldn't register again until I found *COPS* in 1989. If *Wild Kingdom* registered as reality, *COPS* was life. It was the window I wished I could bend a slat of venetian blind at; the pulsing red and blue lights of squad cars washing the apartment, massaging my nose and eyes, interrogating my comfort.

Skipping completely past the fake houses, fake smiles, fake confessions, and fake fights of *The Real World* and its 90s spin-offs, I wouldn't find real-seeming life again on TV til a 2006 Thanksgiving marathon of *Deadliest Catch*. And then real-seeming life was inescapable.

Following *Catch's* premiere, a new class of reality TV filled the time between commercials on cable's HISTORY and DISCOVERY networks. They'd heard Gore Vidal and divined the secret to televising lives worth dropping everything to compulsively consume, if not to actually go out and try living. The Television of Real-Seeming Life had found its niche in the 6 billion dollar a year reality TV market, and I was watching the fuck out of it.

The Television of Real-Seeming Life isn't the reality TV of CBS, ABC, NBC or MTV. ToRSL abandons the hokey elimination competitions and caricatures of reality TV. It trades phony lofts and pineapple vagina juice for primal jungles, wild seas and spear-caught fish. Its lifestyles are exotic not for how inaccessible the manicured auras of its subjects are, but for how available their lives are to anyone undaunted by hard work, hard places and hard luck.

ToRSL obsesses over extraction and refinement—mining, hunting, fishing, survival—and the locations visited in every episode are described with the frequency and care of human characters. The environments, physical and metaphysical, are villains mostly.

I found surrogate families in the Television of Real-Seeming Life. The subjects surrounded me in my studio. They taught me how to skin a moose. They kept me connected to a world I'd grown mostly afraid of. The more meaningful shows became, the more unintentionally aware of their formulas I became. *Really Real Protection from Real-Seeming Life.*

Suspended in the comedy of *Bering Sea Gold Under The Ice's* ambitious narration, laughing every time a location inches from every other location was described, I began transcribing them:

*off the coast of Nome  
300 yards down the ice  
out at the dredge  
three miles west  
at the dive hole of the Anchor Management  
just outside  
in his head*

I've been lost for years. Unsure of my place as an artist, distant from the people who I most love, disengaged from a life I once allowed to pull me so viciously into as many worlds as was its pleasure, that at 39, there's not much left of me but lost. There was something magnetic



in burying myself beneath a pile of locations already mapped by others.  
I was plotting the map of an unknown-to-me in which to stray.

For nine months, I compulsively recorded the places I'd heard about—  
for every one of the thirty shows I'd been watching. Concrete locations,  
thermal points, points in time, things described as subjects gestured  
to them in space, answers to the question *Where?*, aspirations, vectors,  
states. Relentlessly mining lines from shows about relentless extraction.  
With no intention of refinement.

On TV, refinement looked mostly like money or food, but there  
were also quixotic hunters of the abstract who processed discoveries  
less practically. *Ancient Aliens'* UFOlogists and *River Monsters'* Jeremy  
Wade cast evidence into mythology.

I wanted myths. Fictions. Based completely on experiences had only  
thru transcription.

On *Gold Rush Alaska*, I'd seen miners stash their hauls in mason jars.  
I had a *Word* doc. When its line count hit 11,746, it seemed like  
plenty and I let the software alphabetize it. *Washing the dirt*.  
Rinsed of disorder, there were nuggets:

*my pack*  
*my panties*  
*my party*  
*my pistol on my hip right here*  
*my place*  
*my place in the world*  
*my pot*  
*my pride*

I continued melting lines out alphabetically, casting them into maps,  
lists of places that had traveled thru me but where I'd mostly never  
been. 123 alphabetized maps. *1001 Places I've Heard Of*.
